The new facility will consist of a two cell clay-lined facultative lagoon. The treated effluent from the lagoon will be discharged between June 15<sup>th</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup> to a drainage ditch flowing to the Dauphin River and eventually into Lake Winnipeg.
