Re: Notice of Alteration – Ninga Facility (Municipality of Killarney-Turtle Mountain)

Thank you for your letter dated August 9, 2016, requesting approval to proceed with upgrades to the existing development including notification of that the scope of the construction project has changed from the proposal submitted on June 22, 2015. It is indicated that no constructional upgrades will be undertaken to the blender or conveyor system. You have requested approval to proceed with construction of a new concrete inload pad for loading granular fertilizer into the two hopper bins at the facility.

The Environmental Approvals Branch is processing this request as a minor alteration to Environment Act Licence No. 3159 pursuant to clause 14(2) of *The Environment Act*.
