A proposal has been filed by Overton Environmental Enterprises Inc. for the re-establishment and operation of a composting facility in the Rural Municipality of Ste. Anne at NW 25-07-07EPM. A composting facility was previously developed at this location, and the utilization and upgrading of existing infrastructure (compost pad, leachate pond, concrete pads, shed) is proposed. The development will receive industrial and agricultural waste (potato processing waste, feed mill waste, animal bedding with manure) as feedstock for the composting process, with woodchip, grasses and straw as bulking agents. The finished compost will be marketed to offsite buyers. Operation at the facility is proposed to resume in the fall of 2015.
