A proposal has been filed by the Town of Altona and the Municipality of Rhineland to continue to operate the Altona Waste Disposal Grounds; a waste disposal ground located on the SE quarter of Sec. 27, Twp. 2 Rge. 1 WPM in the Municipality of Rhineland. The Development consists of landfill cells, burn cells, a weigh scale, an operator building, an equipment storage building, and storage for metals, tires, used oil, chemical containers, shingles, and areas for stockpiling cover material. In addition, there are old soap stock ponds on the development, which are to be gradually decommissioned, with the area to be used for alternative purposes. The Operators propose to continue to operate the waste disposal ground at this location; which will include construction of new waste cells over the next 25 years, as well as construction and operation of a new compost pad, a leachate evaporation pond and a cut off perimeter wall to surround the waste cells and the evaporation pond.
