Manitoba Sustainable Development has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

<u>MUNICIPALITY OF RUSSELL-BINSCARTH WATER SUPPLY PIPELINES – FILE:</u> 5832.10

A proposal has been received from the Manitoba Water Services Board on behalf of the Municipality of Russell-Binscarth for the construction and operation of treated water pipelines from the Russell water treatment plant to Rossburn and Inglis. The pipelines would be constructed in highway and road right-of-way. The Russell water treatment plant would have a treated water capacity of 32.6 litres per second, and would reject approximately 9.5 litres per second of the raw water entering the plant. Construction of the project is proposed to begin in late 2016 and be completed by March, 2018.
