I submit herewith a site plot plan (location of structure) and plans in duplicate of the proposed structure for approval to Parks and Natural Areas, 200 Saulteaux Cr., in Winnipeg, Manitoba R3J 3W3. I also agree to construct same within one year from date of application or site plan permit if applicable. I also agree to identify the proposed structure(s) with the lot and block location of my vacation home. I am also aware that there is an annual fee per structure that will be charged on my annual invoice.

Note: Using wood treated with creosote or pentachlorophenylin construction near water, including docks, boathouses and retaining walls, is a violation under The Environment Act. Copper chromium arsenate is the most commonly used material in treated wood products, and is a preferred product. Although detailed construction plans for docks are not required, you are to provide general construction features and the size of the dock.

Fisheries and Oceans Canada wishes to review any applications for activities in any provincial park that may occur below the normal high water mark of a waterbody. Manitoba Conservation will only issue permits when satisfied that conditions acceptable to the Department of Fisheries and Oceans have been met.

Transport Canada wishes to review any applications for activities in, upon, over, under, through, or across a navigable water. The activities that occur between the low and high water mark will require approval under the Navigable Waters Protection Act. An authorization may also be required from the Federal Department of Fisheries and Oceans. Manitoba Conservation will only issue permits when satisfied that conditions acceptable to Transport Canada have been met.
