The following topics will be presented at Brereton Lake Campground (Friday), Big Whiteshell Campground (Saturday) and White Lake Campground (Sunday) each week. Look for weekly event posters for detailed event times, locations and specifics.

- June 7 – June 8** **Family Fishing Weekend: Of Fins and Flippers**
Hold on to your fishing rods for this series of *fantastic* events. During Manitoba's Family Fishing Weekend entrance into the park is free and a fishing license is not required (limits still apply).
- June 13 – June 15** **Rock the Whiteshell**
The Whiteshell is home to some of the oldest rocks in the world. Join us as we head back to the beginning of time and the start of our oldest feature.
- June 20 – June 22** **Rocks, Trees and Water**
These habitats make our park a home to hundreds of creatures. Join us as we take a peak at the perfect places for people and animals to share.
- June 27 – June 29** **Canoe Tails & Trails**
Take a journey through time with the interpreters as we discover how people traveled before. Try your hand at making a timeless treat – Bannock.
- June 30 – July 6** **Canada Day: A Clearly Canadian Good Time**
Special Events At *Alfred Hole Goose Sanctuary* and Canadian creatures help us to celebrate Canada Day and the things that make us truly Canadian.
- July 7 – July 13** **Reptiles and Amphibians**
Sciensational Snakes arrive at the *Alfred Hole Goose Sanctuary* with live animals to touch and hold. These ancient creatures hold the honour of being the symbol of our park – do you know why?
- July 14 – July 20** **Parks' days Weekend: Seeing the Forest for the Trees**

- July 28 – August 4** **Wetlands & The Things That Don't Belong**

- August 5 – August 10** **Birds of a Feather**
