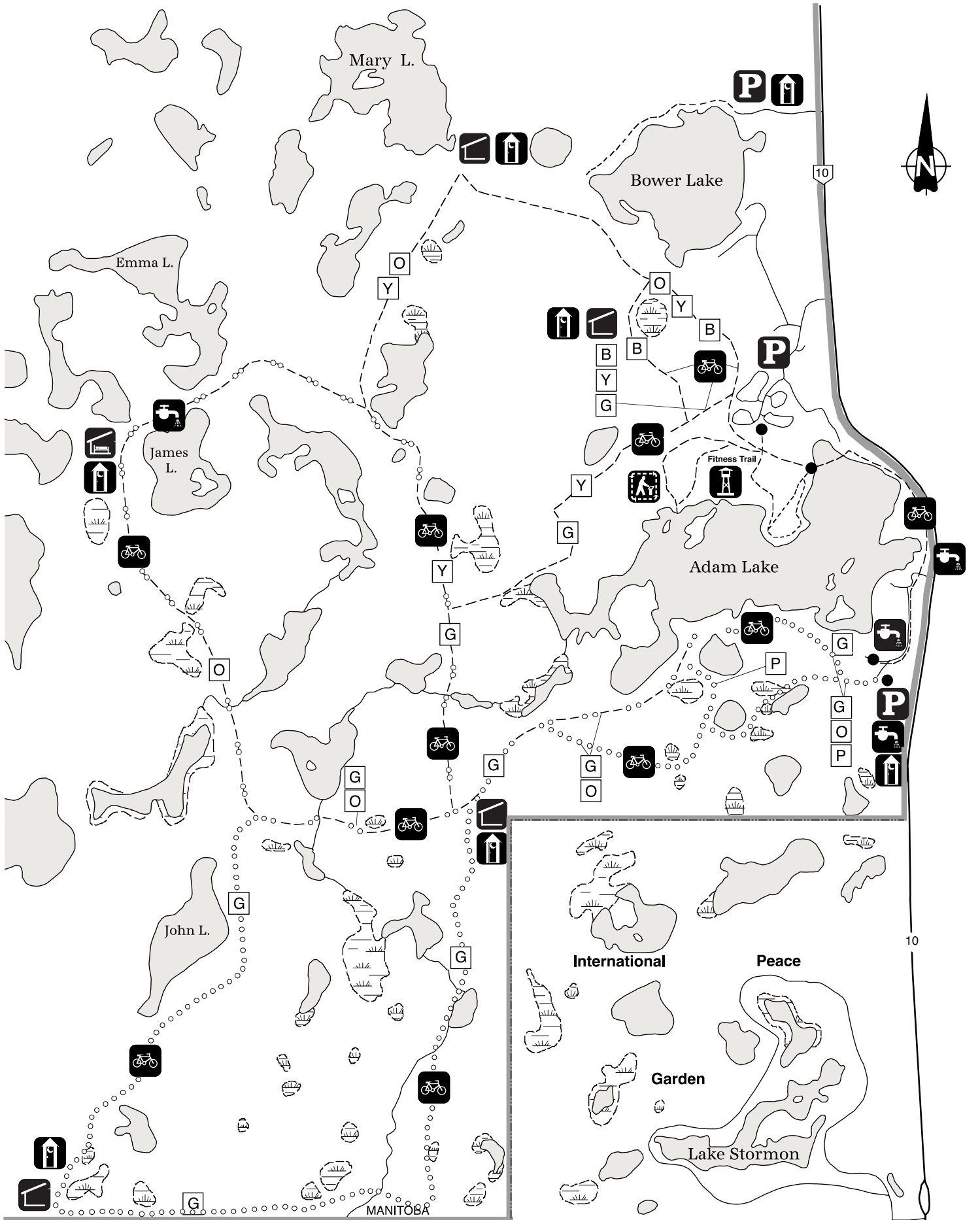

- Shoofly Trail P Purple 3 km

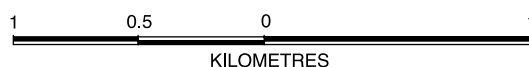

- STARTING POINT - Oskar Lake or Max Lake (Location # 1) (Location # 14)
- ACCESS - Oskar Lake Road - 200 paces in from road.
- Max Lake Campground.
- ROUTE - Circle return route. Counter clockwise route eliminates some steep climbs on portages.
- LENGTH - 19 kilometres including James Lake route.
- TIME - Leisurely weekend trip.
- SEASON - Recommended during spring and fall.

LOCATION	DESCRIPTION
1	Starting area - 200 paces to waters edge. Counter clockwise route eliminates steep hills.
2	Campsite.
3	Oskar Lake Campground - this area is also accessed by a walking trail from the Oskar Lake Road.
4	530 pace portage - good shoreline either side, one steep ravine to cross midway.
5	350 pace portage - good shoreline either side.
6	Isabella Lake campsite on north shore.
7	350 pace portage - good shoreline Isabella Lake side. Approximately 50 m wet shoreline Gravel Lake side.
8	James Lake side route 2 km. ; each portage roughly 150 paces.
9	Overnight cabin - James Lake; for overnight registration contact the Adam Lake Park Office at 534-2026.
10	75 pace portage - good shoreline either side, sharp drop on portage going on to unnamed lake.
11	700 pace portage - wet landing on unnamed lake. Good shoreline off Max Lake.
12	Campsite.
13	Campsite.
14	Alternate staging area - campground.
15	Campsite.
16	250 pace portage - good shoreline either side. The bay on Max Lake side can be shallow on a dry year.
17	Campsite.
18	880 pace portage - good shoreline either side - the longest portage of the route.
19	Staging area - Oskar Lake walk-in Campground. 1600 paces to campground.
20	Low water level may present problems at some portages.
