Park Patrol Officer (RO1 entry level)

Description

Park Patrol officers patrol 22 Provincial Parks throughout the Province. Officers are members of an enforcement team responsible for the delivery of park programs, safety and security of the public. Officers are accountable for investigating any non-compliance and administering the appropriate enforcement options. This position evaluates public complaints, exercises discretion and legislated authorities particularly in regards to park activities and operations.

We offer diverse locations throughout the Province, extensive training, growth and development opportunities. With leadership from departmental supervisors, you will be responsible for maintaining safety, security, distributing information and offering direction to the general public, clients or diversified user groups of the parks system. Employment period begins May through August.

Qualifications

- You must have good communication skills, verbal and written
- Be physically capable of performing regular officer duties
- Have the ability to drive an emergency vehicle
- Have post secondary education in Conservation, Environmental Studies or Law. (*standards vary)
- Have a valid First Aid, CPR and Canadian Firearms Certificate (or possession/ acquisition licence)
- Complete a Departmental Training Course
