POSITION: Park Patrol Captain – Resource Officer 2 (RO2)

Location: Various locations in Manitoba
Length of Employment: Seasonal Dept. Position – approximately 20 weeks (May through Sept. 2012)
Salary Range: Starting salary \$18.33 per hour
Closing Date: November 30, 2011

As Park Patrol Captain, you will be responsible to supervise and participate in the Park Patrol program in the district, and to make recommendations and prepare end of season reports. You will ensure the safety of resource users and the general public; investigate violations and complaints, gather evidence, prepare enforcement documents and carry through from an investigation to a successful prosecution. You may perform duties relating to depredation and predation programs, and provide assistance to staff in various resource disciplines. Depending on location, you may be required to travel backcountry areas, remote river systems, large bodies of water, and be away for extended periods

Required qualifications candidates must have:

- Graduation prior to May 2012, from a recognized college or university in an approved program relating to conservation, renewable resources or law; or an equivalent combination of education/ training and experience (must provide course completion and marks to date, if graduating April 2012).
- Minimum of one season experience as a Park Patrol Officer (RO1) and have completed the department's Park Patrol Training
- Knowledge of law enforcement
- Demonstrated leadership skills
- Ability to work effectively under stress in hostile or adverse environmental conditions
- Ability to work independently with little direct supervision
- Knowledge of operational directives
- Ability to communicate clearly to a broad spectrum of clients
- Good writing skills
- Ability to supervise staff is desired

Your application must clearly indicate how you meet each of the stated qualifications and you must attach a copy of your degree or diploma and certifications, as noted by asterisks () below.**

Candidates must meet the following Conditions of Employment:

- **A valid full Class 4 drivers licence
- **Valid Standard First Aid and CPR certificates
- **A clear criminal record check - must not have been convicted of a criminal offence for which a pardon has not been granted. A current valid original must be obtained from your local police agency and provided prior to March 1, 2012
- Physically able to perform the duties required
