

Wage Subsidy for Job Seekers

Assisting eligible individuals who need on-the-job training to find employment

- We can assist you to secure on-the-job training. You will obtain direct work experience and develop job-specific skills while earning a salary.
- Employment Manitoba will review your request for assistance in relation to your needs, the labour market and the availability of funds.

What services are offered?

Support Services

- counselling and assistance to develop an employment plan
- access to information on occupations and training opportunities

Eligible Training

- minimum of 30 hours per week on-the-job training
- support depends on individual skills development needs, the job requirements identified by the employer and local labour market considerations
- funding will not be provided if you started a job before the Wage Subsidy was approved

The Following Employers Qualify:

- You can market yourself to employers offering ongoing employment opportunities including:
 - private sector employers
 - non-profit and community groups
 - crown corporations
 - public health and education institutions, municipalities, bands and tribal councils

Who can participate?

You may be eligible if you fit into one of these categories:

- Unemployed or working less than an average of 20 hours/week
- Have a current or previous Employment Insurance (EI) claim
- Employed individuals who are low skilled or a lower income individual or family with dependent child(ren)
- An individual who is about to lose your job
