

# Rental Guidelines and Security Deposits

## EMPLOYMENT AND INCOME ASSISTANCE (EIA)

If you live in rented housing, Employment and Income Assistance (EIA) will pay your rent up to a maximum rate. EIA may also help you pay your damage or security deposit up to half of one month's rent guideline rate. Please talk to your worker if you need a damage or security deposit.

### MAXIMUM RENT RATES

If you get EIA benefits and live in private rented housing, EIA will pay your rent up to the following maximum rates:

<b>Family Size</b>	<b>Basic Rent</b>	<b>Rent with Heat, Lights and Water</b>
1 Person *	\$243	\$271
1 Person – Disability	\$243	\$285
2 Persons	\$285	\$387
3 Persons	\$310	\$430
4 Persons	\$351	\$471
5 Persons	\$371	\$488
6 Persons	\$387	\$513

\*A single person in this first category who shares rent or rents a suite with a shared kitchen or bathroom will get a maximum of \$236.00 per month for rent.

## EMPLOYMENT AND INCOME ASSISTANCE (EIA)

### MAXIMUM RENT RATES FOR MANITOBA HOUSING AUTHORITY OR SUBSIDIZED HOUSING

EIA has established the following rental rates to be paid if you are living in Manitoba Housing or subsidized housing. The following table outlines these rates for you.
