- 2) Physicians must report vaccine inventory to Public Health on a weekly basis and/or as directed by Public Health. The system for inventory reporting will be determined by Public Health and communicated to physicians.
- 3) Determination of patient eligibility, intervals since last dose, and obtaining patient consent are included within the fee.
- 4) Physicians shall provide equitable access for vaccinations for all eligible Manitobans regardless of whether the patient is in the physician's existing panel of patients.
- 5) Manitoba Health has determined that this service, when provided during an after-hours period, is not urgent or emergent and therefore After Hours Premiums may not be claimed in addition.
- 6) Physicians must review a patient's electronic COVID-19 immunization history through eChart or PHIMS to review any previous immunization history, interval between doses and product history to ensure all doses administered matches current provincial recommendations.
- 7) Physicians must ensure vaccine products are stored and handled as per the product monographs.
