Physicians must report the eligibility criteria for immunization on the claim in accordance with Public Health guidelines. Physicians must report vaccine inventory to Public Health on a weekly basis and/or as directed by Public Health. The system for inventory reporting will be determined by Public Health and communicated to physicians. Determination of patient eligibility and obtaining patient consent are included within the fee. Physicians are required to schedule a second dose appointment with patients following administration of the first dose. Physicians are required to reasonably follow-up with patients to ensure the second dose is administered within recommended guidelines. Physician's existing panel of patients. Manitoban Health has determined that this service, when provided during an after-hours period, is not urgent or emergent and therefore After Hours Premiums may not be claimed in addition. Physicians must review a patient's electronic COVID-19 immunization history through eChart or PHIMS to review any previous immunization history, interval between doses, if required, and product history to ensure second doses match current provincial recommendations. Physicians must ensure vaccine products are stored and handled as per the product monographs.
