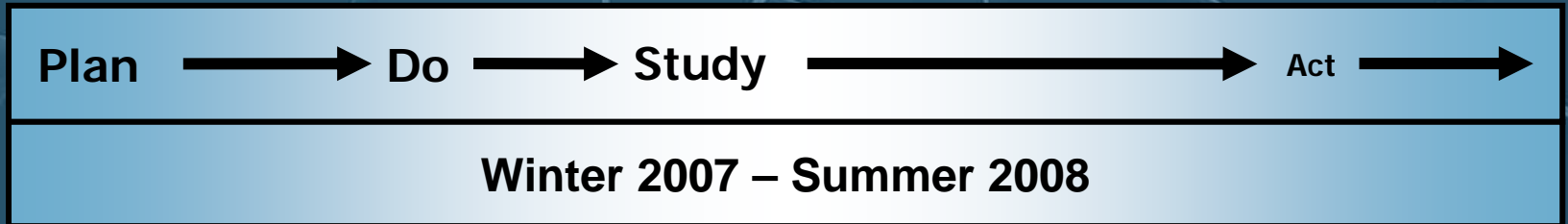

- MCHP Deliverables approved



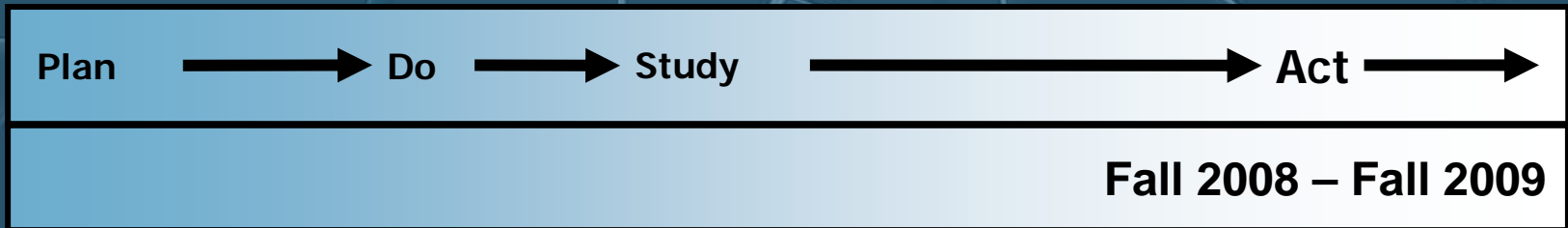
Where We Are: Plan-Do-Study-Act (Con't)

- PCISS work completed



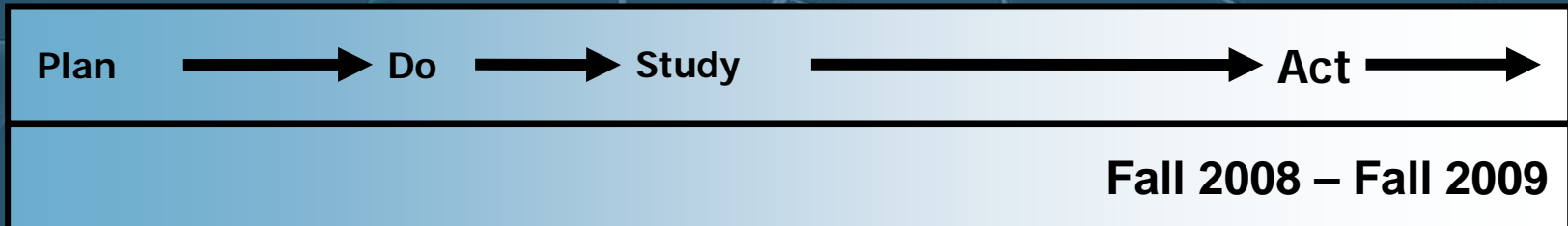
Where We Are Going: Plan-Do-Study-Act (Con't)



- Evaluation of demonstration sites
- 3 demonstration sites sustained for Phase 2
- 1 control site converted to a demonstration site
- Site selection criteria modified based on Phase 1 demonstration site learnings
- New site application process re-developed
- New sites recruited
- Phase 2 demonstration sites commence engagement cycle (information management, change management and quality based incentive funding applied)

- 2nd MCHP deliverable completed
- MB Health quality indicators developed
- MB Quality Based Incentive funding model developed

PIN Deliverables: Overview

MB Health PIN Strategy

Deliverable Development

Ongoing Operation Guided by the Deliverable

Funding & Remuneration

Requires a Manitoba Quality Based Incentive Funding (QBIF) PIN funding model that supports Departmental and Divisional policies and strategies.

Funding model & selection of indicators influence each other; funding is informed by outcome findings from data analysis

Indicator Development

Requires a process for defining and updating indicators for Primary Care that are congruent with national, provincial and regional priorities.

Selection of indicators drives Primary Care EMR Implementation and Support requirements.

Primary Care EMR Implementation and Support

Requires a process for Primary Care EMR Implementation and Support to include the development of sustainable standards, processes and procedures for the capture, extraction and utilization of information.

Selection of indicators and detailed information requirements both determine data to be collected and analyzed.

Data Collection & Analysis

Requires a process for collecting and analyzing data to support PIN evaluation and remuneration within a broader strategy for Divisional and Departmental data collection & analysis.
