Q. When can I start including the annual management of patients with Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder (MH-SUD) in my CCM Tariff Claims?

A. As of September 1, 2020, the annual management of care provided to patients with an applicable MH-SUD diagnosis for the preceding twelve (12) months is eligible for the Comprehensive Care Management (CCM)

Q. What do I have to have in my EMR for supporting documentation?

A. Ensure you have recorded the diagnosis in your EMR of all patients with the following applicable conditions along with the management indicators performed, in addition to the initial qualifying minimum and ongoing management requirements (as outlined in the Manitoba Physician's Manual).

Other data requirements for applicable indicators for patients with a Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder may already be captured in your EMR in the Prevention & Screening category.

It is recommended that the guidelines in the new <u>Primary Care Quality Indicators Guide 4.0</u> are followed until your EMR product has certified and made available the recently revised <u>Primary Care Quality Indicator Reminders and Data Extract Specification (v.4.1).</u>

Q. How do these changes affect the Comprehensive Care Management Tariffs?

A. If a patient has more than one diagnosis within the Mental Health-Substance Use Disorder indicator cluster, this is considered one chronic disease.

Note that for the purpose of CCM tariffs, it is recognized that the Manitoba Primary Care Quality Indicators are subject to patient specific limitations and physician clinical judgement. Manitoba's adjudication of claims submitted by physicians pursuant to the CCM tariffs will continue to be adjudicated accordingly.
