**Re: Updated TB Prescription Forms**

Starting July 1, 2017, all TB prescription forms will be modified to reflect a change in the pharmacy that will be filling TB prescriptions for First Nations clients living in northern/rural communities.

Please note that as of July 1, 2017, TB Prescriptions for First Nations clients living in northern/rural communities should be sent to Grand Medicine Health Services pharmacy (instead of Muskehi pharmacy). Prescription Shop remains the pharmacy to be used for those clients who do not fall within the Grand Medicine Health Services pharmacy criteria.
