

The Data Says

#### **Parent Survey Observations**

Total # of Survey's completed – 79

Percentage currently walking – 60%

Percentage of parents who walked as kids – 78%

34% of student live within 500m of the school.

85% of students live within 1.5 km of the school.

Over 80% of people felt the area was safe.

- 3. Crosswalks






