Neighbourhoods Alive! funding for Elmwood

Out of a continued commitment to strengthening Manitoba communities, Neighbourhoods Alive (NA!) is expanding with \$90,000 for community projects in Elmwood.

In collaboration with neighbourhood groups, NA! will build on the many strengths in the Elmwood community by supporting locally-driven revitalization initiatives in the area. NA! helps foster stronger, safer, more inclusive communities by providing resources and support to local community groups. Projects will enhance opportunities for community participation, recreation, employment, and well-being.

Local community groups will be able to apply for funding through the Neighbourhood Renewal Fund (NRF) for support for various community-focused projects within the Chalmers boundaries of Munroe on the north, Raleigh St. on the east, the river on the south and Henderson Hwy on the west. Application deadline for Elmwood is July 30, 2010.

Community meetings will provide an opportunity to receive information about the NA! expansion in Elmwood, and provide an opportunity for residents to collectively identify community priorities for NA! to use when reviewing project proposals.
