Qualifications

- Cannot own property or vacant land
- Annual household income cannot be greater than \$75,592 with dependants or \$56,694 without dependants
- Property must be the primary residence
- Ability to qualify for a mortgage from a financial institution

At this time, only qualified applicants can purchase the home. If the property is still available in the future, it may be purchased by either qualified or unqualified applicants. Only qualified applicants are eligible for Manitoba Housing's financial contributions.
