

Non-Profit Housing Organizations - Approved Project Listing

Funding for repair and upgrades made available through the Investment in Affordable Housing (IAH) Agreement.

In November 2016, Manitoba Housing issued a request for proposals to non-profit housing organizations for funding for repairs and upgrades at social and affordable housing properties.

In total, more than \$19 million will be provided to these organizations through an expanded federal-provincial commitment to the Investment in Affordable Housing (IAH) agreement. [These projects were announced by the Manitoba government in Spring 2017.](#)

Brandon

- Grey Owl Non-Profit Housing: more than \$149,000 for windows, plumbing and a ventilation unit
- Brandon Friendship Housing Authority: \$290,000 for windows, doors, roofing and eavestroughs

Interlake

- Oak Park Lodge, Woodlands: \$27,000 for sidewalk replacement
- Gateway Manor, Teulon: \$80,000 for windows and lighting upgrades

North

- Thompson Senior Citizens Housing Inc., Thompson: \$221,000 for roofing and drainage

North-central

- Odd Fellows Towers, Portage la Prairie: more than \$207,000 for elevator modernization, automatic doors and electrical

- Westminster Housing Co-op Ltd.: more than \$1.1 million for windows, bathroom upgrades, HVAC, roofing and plumbing
- Kanata Housing Corporation: more than \$1.1 million for windows, doors, roofing, soffits, fascia, eavestroughs, grading, parking and exterior upgrades
- Kinew Housing Inc.: more than \$1.81 million for projects at five properties, including furnaces, ventilation systems, windows, bathroom upgrades, kitchen renovations, roofing, water and sewer repairs, and masonry
- Dakota Ojibway First Nations Housing Authority Inc.: more than \$718,000 for projects at two properties, including doors, windows and roofing
