To date, 56 of 96 projects have been completed....



Through a neighbourhood strategic planning process, residents of each neighbourhood area have defined key community values, needs and issues and have identified and endorsed a number of community projects to address them. Within the six designated neighbourhood areas, a total of 96 community recommended projects were approved and allocated funding through the Building Communities Initiative. While many projects have already been completed, most of the remaining projects will be implemented in 2006.

COMPLETED PROJECTS

- 1 Boyd Park C.C. Water Play - new water play spray features, seating and plantings.
- 2 Boyd Park C.C. Playspace Redevelopment - new play structure, seating and landscaping.
- 3 Margaret Scott Site Redevelopment - skateboard plaza, playing fields and play space redevelopment, seating and lighting.
- 4 Sgt. Tommy Prince MM Veterans Park - community pathway, fencing and drainage improvements
- 5 Nomads Football Lighting Upgrades



PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED IN 2006

- 6 Boyd Park C.C. Playing Field Redevelopment - development of two new mini-soccer fields

PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED IN 2006-07

- 7 Boyd Park Recreation Building – Building Communities staff is currently working with the Board of Sinclair Park Community Centre and the General Council of Winnipeg Community Centres, to ensure that the funding addresses the community’s long-term recreation programming and facility needs.
- 8 Sgt. Tommy Prince (Phase Two) – Parade grounds/Plaza, native plantings, drainage improvements
- 9 Margaret Scott Site Redevelopment (Phase Two) – Fencing upgrades, planting and graffiti art
