



The **Building Communities Initiative** was launched by the **Province of Manitoba** and the **City of Winnipeg** in February, 2002, as a five year, **\$14 million** co-funded capital investment

- > **St. George and Worthington**

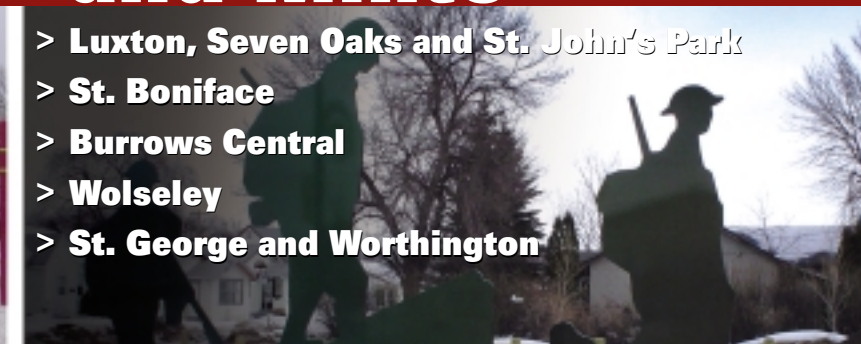

To date, 56 of 96 projects have been completed....



Through a neighbourhood strategic planning process, residents of each neighbourhood area have defined key community values, needs and issues and have identified and endorsed a number of community projects to address them. Within the six designated neighbourhood areas, a total of 96 community recommended projects were approved and allocated funding through the Building Communities Initiative. While many projects have already been completed, most of the remaining projects will be implemented in 2006.

- ⑧ Sargent Park School Basketball Court and Site Enhancements
- ⑨ Principal Sparling School Playground Redevelopment
- ⑩ Sargent Park Recreation Complex Framework Plan – Facility Assessment and Framework Plan to guide future facility and site improvements.

PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED IN 2006

- ⑪ Community Skateboard Park – concrete 'street style' skateboard park for all ages and skill levels to be located at Sargent Park Recreation Complex site.
- ⑫ Streetscaping Enhancements – installation of information kiosks, planters, lighting and signage.

PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED IN 2007

- ⑬ Isaac Brock Community Centre Renovation/Expansion – Building Communities staff is currently working with the Board of Isaac Brock Community Centre and the General Council of Winnipeg Community Centres, to ensure that the funding addresses the community's long-term recreation programming and facility needs
