**To date, 56 of 96 projects have been completed....**



Through a neighbourhood strategic planning process, residents of each neighbourhood area have defined key community values, needs and issues and have identified and endorsed a number of community projects to address them. Within the six designated neighbourhood areas, a total of 96 community recommended projects were approved and allocated funding through the Building Communities Initiative. While many projects have already been completed, most of the remaining projects will be implemented in 2006.

## PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED IN 2006

- 8 Bishop Grandin Greenway Pathway between St. Anne's Rd. and Dakota Street (70% complete) – construction of asphalt multi-use pathway between Dakota Street and St. Anne's Road.
- 9 Bishop Grandin Greenway Community Gardens – garden plots within the Greenway for use by area residents.
- 10 Bishop Grandin Greenway Community Education Area – seating and gathering area for school environmental education programs.
- 11 Glenlee C.C. Site Improvements – Paving of parking lot and hockey pen, tree planting and basketball court.

## PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED IN 2007

- 12 Glenlee Community Centre Gymnasium – Building Communities staff is currently working with the Board of Glenlee Community Centre and the General Council of Winnipeg Community Centres, to ensure that the funding addresses the community's long-term recreation programming and facility needs.
