The Government of Manitoba recognizes the need for a comprehensive and accessible geoscience database. We are committed to collecting and disseminating information on Manitoba's geology, because we understand that this information is one of the most valuable services we can provide to communities and the exploration and mining industry.

We continue to support this commitment, most recently through initiatives like the Manitoba Geoscience Advantage Program, which is providing \$400,000 a year for the next three years to increase our geoscience knowledge-base, and the new, completely redesigned GIS Map Gallery to improve the quality and stability of online access to geoscientific and mineral tenure information.
