The Department of Agriculture and Resource Development (ARD), Regulatory Services Branch (Petroleum) is considering applications for well licence extensions. If approved, the well license will be valid for 2 years from the original date of issue.

Applications may be submitted for all well licences that are set to expire on or after May 1, 2020. For each well on the application, please fill in the attestation form in Appendix 1. The attestation form must include the following:

- 1. Confirmation that all mineral agreements will be valid over the extension period and/or whether they are held by production or unitization. Top leases must be submitted to the branch if the lease will expire within the year of extension.
- 2. Confirmation that the survey platte is current. If there are any surface improvements that took place, a new survey must be attached.
- 3. Confirmation that the surface lease is still valid.
- 4. Confirmation that the consent of occupant is valid.
