PUBLIC OFFERING OF CROWN OIL AND GAS RIGHTS

The undersigned will receive offers to purchase oil and gas leases as described in **SCHEDULE A**, up to 1:00 P.M. (Manitoba official time) on the 13th day of May, 2009.

Each offer should be enclosed in a separately sealed envelope with "Lease Offer – May 13, 2009" clearly indicated on the outside of the envelope, and be accompanied, where applicable, by the following:

- a) The cash bid of the bidder;
- b) Rent for each lease for the first year at the rate of \$3.50 per hectare;
- c) An application fee of \$400.00 per lease;
- d) Method of payment (electronic transfer of funds company account);
- e) The full name and address for service of the party the agreement is to be issued to;
- f) Where the agreement is to be issued in undivided interests, each interest should be clearly indicated;
- g) The G.S.T. Registration Number for each party wishing to have an interest in the agreement.

The bonus, rental and fee must be submitted by electronic funds transfer. All authorizations for electronic funds transfer must be filed with the Branch on an approved form (Attachment No. 1) as set forth in Informational Notice 97-2 (enclosed). It is the company's responsibility to ensure that relevant account information remains current. A company may cancel this authorization at any time by written notice to the Petroleum Registrar. Authorizations for the May 13, 2009 sale must be received no later than April 15, 2009. Bank drafts and certified cheques will not be accepted, unless the bidder has been granted special prior exemption by the Petroleum Registrar.

The bidder is responsible for having sufficient funds in its account on sale day to cover all bids, rentals and fees. If the Branch is notified by the bank that insufficient funds are available, the parcel(s) will be awarded to the next highest bidder. Manitoba reserves the right to refuse future bids and/or posting requests by that bidder.

The bidder may request that consideration be given on another parcel or parcels, if an offer on one or more parcels is not successful, provided that the intent and order of choice is clearly stated and provided that alternative offers are for specific amounts. Any offer received contrary to these conditions or the regulation, will not be considered.

ADDENDUM TO PUBLIC OFFERING OF CROWN OIL AND GAS RIGHTS

May 13, 2009

Parcel No. A1

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area possibly under Conservation Agreement. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A8

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Ferruginous Hawks, a species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A9

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing Bicknell's Sedge, a provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A12

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing Narrow-leaved Milkvetch, a provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A13

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Burrowing Owls, Sprague's Pipits and Loggerhead Shrikes, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act* as well as Narrow-leaved Milkvetch a provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A14

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Sprague's Pipit and Ferruginous Hawks, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel Nos. A16 and A17

These parcels are under private surface ownership in areas containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes. Parcel A16 containing Loggerhead Shrikes, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Parcel A17 containing Baird's Sparrow protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. Both parcels also contain Narrow-leaved Milkvetch and Tall Lungwort provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in these areas.

Parcel Nos. A18 and A19

These parcels are under private surface ownership in areas containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Sprague's Pipits and Loggerhead Shrikes, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. These parcels also contain Narrow-leaved Milkvetch, Plains Rough Fescue with Parcel A18 also containing Tall Lungwort all of which are provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in these areas.

Parcel Nos. A20 and A21

These parcels are under private surface ownership in areas containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Burrowing Owls and Sprague's Pipits, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. Both parcels also contain Narrow-leaved Milkvetch and Tall Lungwort provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in these areas.

Parcel No. A22

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area possibly under Conservation Agreement and adjacent to a section of Crown Land that has been identified as a potential ecological reserve. This proposed ecological reserve is native mixed-grass prairie and although not currently protected, adjacent developments should take this into consideration. This parcel also contains habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Sprague's Pipit and Ferruginous Hawks, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. This parcel also contains Narrow-leaved Milkvetch and Plains Rough Fescue, provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel Nos. A23 and A24

These parcels are under private surface ownership in areas containing a provincially rare species of Wild Ginger. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in these areas.

Parcel A23 is adjacent to Nature Conservancy of Canada owned land. Any exploration activity or development should take into consideration the natural values of the adjacent site.

Parcel No. A27

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing rare species of Bicknell's Sedge and Engelmann's Spike-rush. For avoidance or mitigation of habitat loss, special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A29

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and also containing provincially rare species as Narrow-leaved Milkvetch, Hall's Sedge, Golden Bean, Yellow Stargrass and Tall Lungwort. For avoidance or mitigation of habitat loss, special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A31

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Sprague's Pipit, Ferruginous Hawks and Silky Prairie-clover, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act* as well as Grasshopper Sparrow, a provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel No. A32

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Sprague's Pipit and Burrowing Owls, species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. This parcel also contains provincially rare species of the Grasshopper Sparrow. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel Nos. A33 and A34

These parcels are under private surface ownership in an area utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Grasshopper Sparrow, a provincially rare species. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in these areas.

Parcel A35

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Sprague's Pipit and a species of Silky Prairie-clover all of which are protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. This parcel also contains provincially rare species of the Grasshopper Sparrow. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel Nos. A36 and A37

These parcels are under private surface ownership in areas containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Baird's Sparrow, a species protected under the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. These parcels also contain Silky Prairie-clover which is protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*, and also contain provincially rare species of the Grasshopper Sparrow. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in these areas.

Parcel A38

The Northwest Quarter of this parcel is under private surface ownership. This entire parcel is in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Sprague's Pipits, a species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. Surface access on portions of this parcel for the purpose of exploration or development may be restricted. Prior to any activity in this area, the holder will be required to obtain the approval of the Director of Western Region, Manitoba Conservation and the Director of Petroleum, Manitoba Science Technology Energy and Mines of a development plan. Activities in this area will be permitted only if they fully comply with an approved development plan.

Parcel A42

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing habitat utilized for nesting and foraging purposes by Loggerhead Shrike, a species protected under the federal *Species at Risk Act* and the *Manitoba Endangered Species Act*. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel Nos. A46, A47 and A48

These parcels are under private surface ownership and fall adjacent to the Upper Assiniboine Willen Unit Wildlife Management Area (WMA). This WMA is also an area of special interest targeted for protection. Exploration activity should preserve the natural values of the adjacent WMA. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in these areas.

Parcel A54

This parcel is under private surface ownership in an area containing provincially rare species of Tufted Fleabane and Schweinitz's Flatsedge. Special conditions may be placed on drilling and production operations in this area.

Parcel Nos. A38, A39, A40, A41, A42, A43, A44, A45, A46, A47, A48 and A49

Other than portions of Parcel A38, these parcels are under private surface ownership. These parcels are in an area containing Potash Permit QP-172, issued to Western Potash Corp.

Parcel Nos. A51, A52, A53 and A54

These parcels are under private surface ownership in an area containing Potash Permit QP-168, issued to W. S. Ferreira Ltd.

Parcel Nos. A10, A11, A12, A13, A14, A15, A16, A17, A18, A19 and A20

INFORMATIONAL NOTICE 05-02

Withdrawal of Crown Oil and Gas Rights from Disposition

Effective immediately, the Department of Industry, Economic Development and Mines will not be accepting applications under Subsection 2(2) of the Crown Disposition Regulation for the disposition of Crown oil and gas rights by public sale in the area currently under potash disposition for exploration and/or development ("potash disposition area") outlined in Schedule A. This Notice does not affect the rights of holders of existing dispositions of Crown oil and gas rights in the potash disposition area.


A potash lease in the Russell area has been held by the Manitoba Potash Corporate since 1987. The Department is in the process of issuing a potash exploration permit in the St. Lazare area to Agrium Inc. The term of the potash exploration permit is five years and may be extended in accordance with the provisions of the Potash Exploration Permit Regulation under *The Mines and Minerals Act*.

Oil and gas operations have the potential to adversely impact the integrity of potash deposits. In order to mitigate this risk, the Department has decided not to dispose of Crown oil and gas rights in the potash disposition area while holders of potash dispositions undertake activities to evaluate potash deposits. The Department hopes the orderly development of the province's subsurface resources will maximize the value of these resources for the future benefit of all Manitobans.

The Department's decision not to dispose of oil and gas rights in the potash disposition area will be reviewed at the end of the term of the potash exploration permit or earlier in the event of surrender of all or a portion of the permit area or termination of the potash lease or exploration permit.

Mandatory Electronic Fund Transfer at Manitoba Public Offerings of Crown Oil and Gas Lease Rights

On August 23, 1995, the Petroleum and Energy Branch introduced electronic transfer of funds for payment of bonuses, rentals and fees submitted with bid offerings at Manitoba Public Offerings of Crown Oil and Gas Lease Rights. This initiative has been very well received by industry and has resulted in a significant reduction in administrative activities for both industry and Branch staff. Over the last few sales, the majority of revenue has been collected in this manner.

To further streamline Crown oil and gas lease sale procedures, the Branch has decided, effective with the August 13, 1997 sale, to make payment of bonuses, rentals and fees submitted with bid offerings by electronic fund transfer, mandatory. As of this date, bank drafts or certified cheques will no longer be accepted unless the bidder has been granted special exemption by the Petroleum Registrar.

All authorizations for electronic fund transfer must be filed with the Branch on an approved form (Attachment No. 1). The authorization should be prepared on company letterhead, witnessed or executed under seal and submitted to the Branch not less than one week prior to the date of the sale. Authorizations for the upcoming May 14, 1997 sale must be received no later than May 7, 1997.

An authorization provided to the Branch does not have to be renewed for each sale. However, it is the company's responsibility to ensure that relevant account information remains current. A company may cancel this authorization at any time by written notice to the Petroleum Registrar.

On sale day, once the successful bids are determined, the total amount owing by the company (any bonus, rental or fee) will be electronically withdrawn from the company's account.

The bidder is responsible for having sufficient funds in its account on sale day to cover all its bids, rentals and fees. If we are notified by the bank that insufficient funds are available, the parcel(s) will be awarded to the next highest bidder. The Department reserves the right to refuse future bids and/or posting requests by that bidder.


