## What is the policy?

This policy outlines procedures for destruction of election material, pursuant to the *Community Councils Election* regulation M.R. 71/2009.

## **Community responsibilities**

- On the second day after the election, the senior election official must retain all the used election
  material from the election for six months. Where an application has been made in court on the
  election, the senior election official must retain the election materials until a decision has been
  reached by the court.
- At six months, the senior election official can proceed to destroy the election material in the
  presence of two witnesses. All material shall be burned or shredded to ensure there is no way to
  determine any written words.
- The attached statutory declaration (See Appendix E4-A) must be completed and kept on file in the council office.
