History

Fisher Bay is adjacent to the northern boundary of the Fisher River reserve (Koostatak).

Access

The community is located on the west shore of Lake Winnipeg and 215 kilometres north of Winnipeg. Provincial Road 224 connects Fisher Bay to the provincial highway system through the reserve.

Governance

The community is represented by a mayor and council under The Northern Affairs Act.

Economic Overview

Residents engage in commercial fishing on Lake Winnipeg. Fishers use the Catfish Creek, George's Island, Jackhead, Koostatak and McBeth fish stations. Some income is generated from trapping in open areas which are not part of a Registered Trapline Zone. A small amount of income is made from seasonal pulp logging.
