Solder or braze piping Install, repair and maintain plumbing fixtures and systems Measure, cut, thread and bend pipes to required shape and size Install sewage disposal system Cut holes to accommodate pipes and fittings Locate and mark position of pipe connections, holes and fixtures Start up and reactivate systems Erect scaffolding, ladders, lifts and other temporary work platforms Determine layout requirements Rig material and equipment Troubleshoot systems Weld pipes using silfoss Install drainage, waste and venting systems Cut openings for pipes in walls, ceilings or floors Select type and size of pipe Weld, braze, cement or solder pipes and joints Remove and replace defective components Install clamps, brackets and hangers to support piping and sprinkling systems Join pipes with couplings, clamps, screws, bolts or cement Select and install pumps Willing and able to work at heights Willing and able to work in confined areas
