

THE BROWN BOOK 2015

SET FINE CATEGORIES

Each offence is assigned a letter (A to J) to indicate the fine category.

Each fine category equals a specific amount (see chart below) that the peace officer can enter as the "Amount Due" on the offence notice form. The Amount Due for each category includes fine, costs, and applicable surcharges.

For some offences there may be specific instructions for calculating the Amount Due. Calculate as instructed and enter total in Amount Due area on the offence notice.

**** TO BE DETERMINED or NO SET FINE**

If you see "To Be Determined" (in the Brown Book) or "no set fine" (in the *Offence Notices Regulation*):

- Check mark the box to indicate "To Be Determined by a Justice"
- Do not enter anything in the amount due area
- Do not write NSF or No Set Fine

PREFACE

The *Offence Notices Regulation* authorizes abbreviated wording and the amount due for charges issued on a common offence notice.

Schedule A to the *Offence Notices Regulation* sets out the authorized abbreviated wording and the Amount Due coding for numerous individual statute and regulatory offences.

NOTE: When a set fine is authorized by the *Offence Notices Regulation*, it is at the discretion of the issuing officer to either:

- enter the authorized set fine in the Amount Due area on the offence notice; or
- check mark the box indicating “To Be Determined by a Justice”.

BROWN BOOK CONTAINS “COMMON” OFFENCES ONLY

The Brown Book is a **partial reprint** of the *Offence Notices Regulation*, containing offences that are commonly issued by a variety of enforcement agencies for easy reference purposes.

REFERENCE NOTES

CHOICE OF WORD OR PHRASE IN DESCRIPTION OF OFFENCE

A “bullet” (i.e. “●”) is used in the abbreviated wordings of the Brown Book to identify when there is a choice as to which word or phrase the peace officer will use when describing the offence.

OFFENCES NOT LISTED IN THE BROWN BOOK OR THE OFFENCE NOTICES REGULATION

For provincial statute or regulatory offences not covered in either the Brown Book or the *Offence Notices Regulation*, peace officers may still issue a charge on a common offence notice, but they must:

- use the formal wording to describe the offence, and
- check mark the box indicating “To Be Determined by a Justice”.

In these situations, many peace officers prefer to lay the charge on an Information and have the accused make a court appearance.

“C”, “D”, OR “I” DEFINITION

In some cases, the appropriate set fine depends on whether the accused is a Corporation, Dealer, or Individual. These situations are identified by a “C” for corporation, a “D” for dealer, or an “I” for individual, in front of the fine category.

of this Act, or any provision of section 249, 252, 253, 254, 255, 259 or 335 of the *Criminal Code* has been committed, whether it has been committed or not, and who, on reasonable and probable grounds, believes that any person has committed such a violation, may arrest that person without warrant whether he is guilty or not.

WILDLIFE ACT

POWERS OF ARREST

70(2) An officer, upon witnessing the commission of an offence under this Act or the regulations, may without process arrest the person committing the offence and bring him before a court of competent jurisdiction to be dealt with according to law.

LIQUOR AND GAMING CONTROL ACT

ARREST WITHOUT WARRANT

127 An inspector who witnesses a person apparently committing an offence under this Act may arrest the person without a warrant

However, the accused may choose to respond to either 373 Broadway or any **regional** Provincial Court Centre*. (Access to offence notice details is available at regional court centres on automated CON system by first appearance date). In addition there are other options and instructions for the accused on the back of the summons.

*This does not include 408 York Avenue, Winnipeg, MB. or the St. Boniface Court location.

FILE NEW OFFENCE NOTICES WITH PROVINCIAL COURT - 373 BROADWAY

APPENDIX D LEGAL WEIGHTS AND DIMENSIONS ENFORCEMENT GUIDE

NOTE: This guide does not fully address tandem axle steering and tridem axle drives, wide-base tires, and does not differentiate between RTAC and non-RTAC vehicles. All officers making use of this guide should refer to the regulation MR575/88 Vehicle Weights and Dimensions on Classes of Highways Regulation for more detailed information when laying charges.

APPENDIX F CHILD CAR SEAT SAFETY CHECK

HTA186(9) No person shall drive a motor vehicle on a highway unless every passenger who is of an age, weight or height specified in the regulations is properly seated and restrained in a child restraining device as required by the regulations.

EXEMPTIONS:

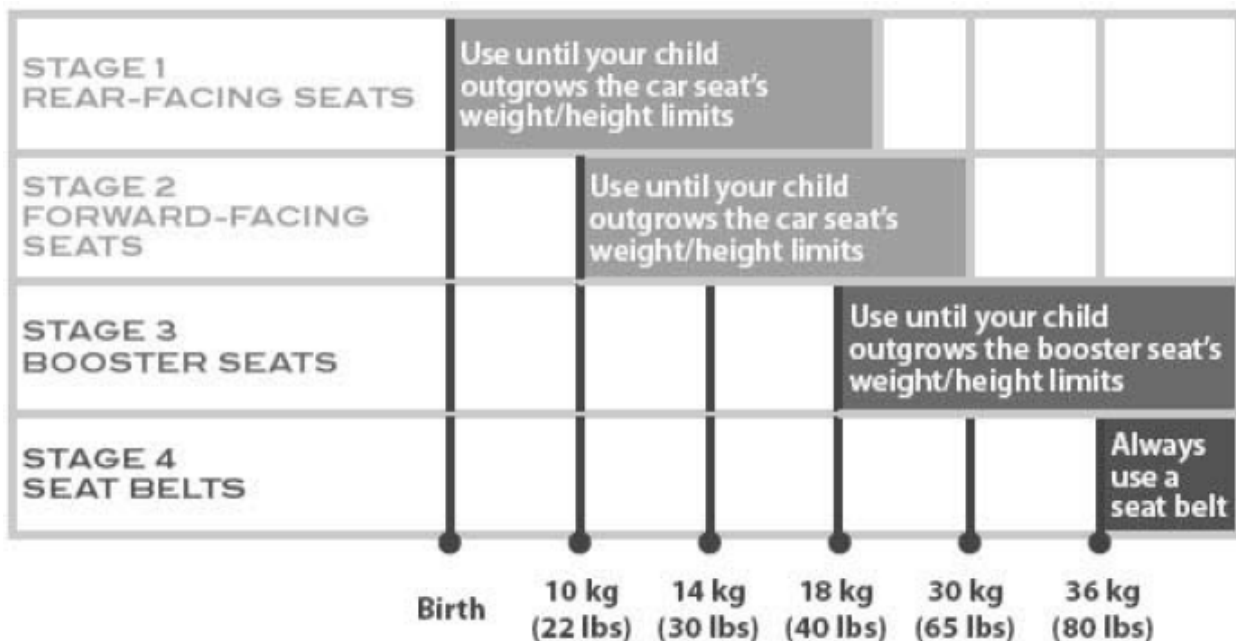
The requirement does not apply when:

- The motor vehicle is registered in a jurisdiction that does not require the use of child restraining devices by persons who are the passenger's age, weight or height or who have the passenger's physical characteristics or special needs;
- The vehicle is a rental vehicle that is rented for a period of 21 days or less;
- The vehicle is a taxicab or livery transporting a passenger for hire;
- The driver can present a medical certificate certifying that the person is, during the period stated in the certificate, unable for medical reasons to be seated or restrained in a child restraining device, and the certificate is produced to a peace officer on request;
- A peace officer is satisfied that, by reason of the passenger's size, build or other physical characteristics, the passenger is unable to be seated or restrained in a child restraining device;
- A child is being transported casually or occasionally by a person who is not the parent or guardian and the vehicle is not equipped with a child restraining device that is suitable for the passenger's use in accordance with this regulation;
- The motor vehicle is not required to be equipped with safety belts by the *Motor Vehicle Safety Regulations* (e.g. buses, vehicles manufactured before 1971).

The *Child Restraining Devices Regulation* requires the use of booster seats until children are at least:

- 145 centimetres (4'9") tall;
- 36 kilograms (80 pounds); OR
- nine years old.

Before using the Child Car Seat Safety Checklist on the next page – request the child’s age, weight and height, then refer to the chart below to determine the type of child restraint that should be used:

LAW ENFORCEMENT CHILD CAR SEAT SAFETY CHECKLIST

- Restraint used is appropriate for age, weight and height profile
- Child Car Seat is compliant with Canadian standards, is CMVSS approved and has the National Safety Mark (Canadian Maple Leaf sticker) visible on the child restraint.
- Restraint is in correct position (front or rear facing): rear-facing for infants under the age of one, and front-facing for infants one year and older. **NOTE: This is a recommendation only; it is not law.**
- Infant seat is not located in front of an active passenger air bag
- Infant seat: carrying handle is in the down position unless otherwise specified from the car seat manufacturer.
- Car seat: is secured snugly with either the lap belt (rear facing car seat stage only), lap/shoulder assembly, or latch system
- Harness strap comes near child's shoulders, slightly above or below as required by manufacturer
- Chest clip is at the underarm level
- Forward-facing toddler seat is secured with a tether strap and an anchor bolt, and one of the following: a seat belt or latch system. **NOTE: the tether strap should be secured to an appropriate anchor bolt.**
- Anchor bolt is drilled into the metal frame of the vehicle
- Tether strap is doubled back through the adjuster slide to prevent slippage. **NOTE: not required for airline type buckles**
- Head and neck are supported to prevent whiplash
- For seatbelt assemblies with emergency locking retractors: free sliding latch plate has a locking clip
- Harness strap is snug – one finger fits snugly between the harness strap and the child's chest
- Harness strap is doubled back through the adjuster slides or they are attached to a metal harness bracket to prevent slippage
- Booster seat: shoulder strap of seat belt assembly passes over the chest and shoulder of a child and that the lap belt fits snug across the child's hips
