On December 17, 2007, an admission of disciplinary default was entered on behalf of Sergeant S.B., with respect to count #4 on the Notice of Alleged Disciplinary Defaults, to wit:

Abuse their authority by using oppressive or abusive conduct or language to the complainants, contrary to section 29(a)(iii) of *The Law Enforcement Review Act*.

Those complainants were M.F. and A.C. as the complainant L.S. was struck from the complaint.

The parties agreed to a penalty of two days forfeiture of pay and requested that I order this penalty pursuant to section 30(1)(e) of the Act. I did so.

All other charges were withdrawn against Sergeant B. and all of the other respondent officers.

NOTE: For the purposes of distribution, personal information has been removed by the Commissioner.

I am directing that this penalty be recorded on the service record of the officer pursuant to section 28(c) of the Act.
