I realize that she resides in another province but it has gone on long enough and so at this point in time I am going to be prepared to grant the motion requested and I am going to dismiss this matter.

I will be sending a letter outlining that to the complainant and a copy to both counsel just so they know what was sent on the file. And as well, I believe that it is probably appropriate that a transcript be ordered and simply put on the file so that a record of the proceedings today is there.
