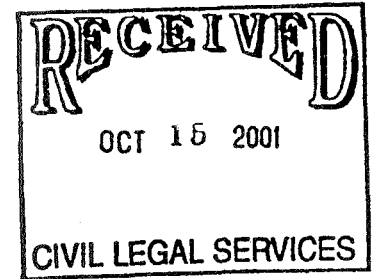




MEMORANDUM TO FILE


