



AUDIOLOGISTS

Audiologists are professionals who identify, diagnose and treat hearing loss in infants, children and adults. They may assist with the selection, fitting and purchase of hearing instruments, and recommend language acquisition and hearing strategies, and provide counseling and support to clients and their families. They work in hospitals, schools, clinics, rehabilitation centres, special institutions, government agencies or private practice.

Audiology is a profession and as such it is regulated in the province of Manitoba. To be able to practice audiology in Manitoba you must be registered with the Manitoba Speech and Hearing Association (MSHA).
