On motion of Hon. Mr. STRUTHERS, Bill (No. 39) – The Budget Implementation and Tax Statutes Amendment Act, 2012/Loi d'exécution du budget de 2012 et modifiant diverses dispositions législatives en matière de fiscalité, was read a First Time and had its purposes outlined.

The following petition was presented and read:

Mr. GOERTZEN – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to request that the Minister of Health to ensure additional personal care homes and long-term care space are made available in the City of Steinbach on a priority basis. (M. Friesen, A. Janz, N. Riega others)

During Oral Questions, Mr. Speaker interjected and ruled that the word "mendacity" spoken by the Honourable First Minister was unparliamentary.

Pursuant to Rule 26(1), Mr. FRIESEN, Hon. Mr. MACKINTOSH, Messrs. SARAN and WISHART and Hon. Mr. GERRARD made Members' Statements.

The House resumed the Adjourned Debate on the Proposed Motion of Hon. Ms. OSWALD:

THAT Bill (No. 6) – The Regional Health Authorities Amendment Act (Improved Fiscal Responsibility and Community Involvement)/Loi modifiant la Loi sur les offices régionaux de la santé (accroissement de la responsabilité financière et de la participation communautaire), be now read a Second Time and be referred to a Committee of this House.

And Mrs. DRIEDGER and Messrs. HELWER, EWAKSO and CULLEN having spoken,

And the Question being put. It was agreed to.

The Bill was accordingly read a Second Time and referred to a Committee of this House.

The House resumed the Adjourned Debate on the Proposed Motion of Hon. Ms. ALLAN:

THAT Bill (No. 21) – The Public Schools Amendment Act (Code of Conduct for School Trustees)/Loi modifiant la Loi sur les écoles publiques (code de conduite à l'intention des commissaires d'écoles), be now read a Second Time and be referred to a Committee of this House.

And the debate continuing,

And leave having been denied to have the matter remain in the name of Mr. CULLEN,

And Messrs. FRIESEN, EWASKO and SCHULER having spoken,

And the Question being put. It was agreed to.

The Bill was accordingly read a Second Time and referred to a Committee of this House.

During the debate, Mr. Speaker interjected and cautioned the Honourable Member for St. Paul with regards to the use of the words "not tell the truth",

Hon. Ms. IRVIN-ROSS moved:

THAT Bill (No. 7) – The Community Renewal Act/Loi sur la revalorisation des collectivités, be now read a Second Time and be referred to a Committee of this House.
