The following petitions were presented and read:

The Order of the Day having been read for consideration of Report Stage Amendment of Bill (No. 71) – The Animal Diseases Amendment Act/Loi modifiant la Loi sur les maladies des animaux, reported from the Standing Committee on Social and Economic Development:

Hon. Mr. Kostyshyn moved:

THAT Bill 71 be amended in Clause 13 by adding the following after the proposed section 9.1:

Biosecurity measures to be taken by inspectors

9.2 Before entering a place, area or vehicle for the purpose of any provision of this Act or a regulation made under this Act, a person — including the director, an inspector or another person — must take the biosecurity measures or comply with the biosecurity standards prescribed by regulation in respect of the category of place, area or vehicle.
