PRAYER

The following petitions were presented and read:

Mr. SMOOK – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Minister responsible for Manitoba Hydro to immediately provide a written explanation to all Members of the Legislative Assembly regarding what criteria were used and the reasons for selecting the preferred routing for the Minnesota-Manitoba Transmission Line including whether or not this routing represented the least intrusive option to residents of Tache, Springfield, St. Anne, Stuartburn, Piney and La Broquerie. (L. Wachal, H. Wilson, C. Monchamp and others)

Mr. SCHULER – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to request that the Ministers of Family Services, Education and Advanced Learning, and Health consider making funding available to address the current waiting list for ABA Services. (G. Mercier, K. Koop, D. Roncadin and others)

Mr. EWASKO – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to consider collaborating with other levels of government to research the economic benefits and construction costs of a marina in Lac du Bonnet. (S. Marty, D. Pefo, C. Grant and others)

Mr. MARTIN – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Minister of Infrastructure and Transportation to recognize the potential danger of allowing high speed travel on a gravel road immediately adjacent to a walking path and to consider reducing the speed limit along Road 9E similar to Road 47NE and Vouriot Road. (K. Peters, K. Peters, A. Giesbrecht and others)

Mr. PEDERSEN – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge that the Provincial Government repair and reopen the Provincial Roads 415 and 416 to allow adequate east-west travel in the Interlake. (K. Bibeau, J. Sweezie, L. Slater and others)
