Objectives:	Students will research and learn about prominent First Nation, Métis, and Inuit people in Canada. Students will orally present their information to their classmates.
Resources	 Screen or monitor for video viewing Access to computers/the internet Library access

Activating

Students will view the following videos:

- Baker, Angela. The Spirit of Annie Mae. National Film Board of Canada, 2002.
- Taylor, Drew Hayden. Redskins, Tricksters and Puppy Stew. National Film Board of Canada, 2000.
- Three episodes of the television show *Sharing Circle* (1991-2008) titled:
 - Women Leaders (highlights three Aboriginal/Métis women who have made a difference)
 - Jordin Tootoo Natural Born Predator (Highlights the life of Jordin Tootoo, the first Inuit hockey player from Nunavut)
 - o Reggie Leach Returning Warrior(Highlights the life of Reggie Leach, the first Métis hockey superstar of the 1970s)

Acquiring

Give students the following project, and allow them time to research and compile information.

Directions: You will choose a First Nation, Métis, or Inuit person of interest to research in order to learn more about their life and contributions.

- You may choose a person from the list provided, or choose someone else you are interested in
- You will make notes of the information you gather before creating a "good copy" worksheet
- Colour the outside border of the worksheet so that your finished work looks like a photo frame
- You may use textbooks, library books, or online resources to gather information

Applying

Students will present their completed image frame to the class, and then hand in to you.

Assessing

Image frames will be assessed using the following criteria:

- Name (1 mark)

- Birthplace (1 mark)
- Date of Birth (1 mark)
- Picture (2 marks)

- Important life events (5 marks for 5 points)
- Most important achievements (5 marks)
- Spelling and Grammar (2 marks)
- Colouring and appearance (2 marks)
