For Manitoba students

Teachers instructing students in Grades 4 through 12 are encouraged to take part in this exceptional, non-partisan program. The Classroom in the Legislature program combines discussion and inter-active games to bring the democratic process alive for your students. Programs have been designed to incorporate Manitoba social studies curriculum components as it pertains to the democratic system. When you book your classroom visit at the building, a tour and, if the Legislature is in session, viewing of House proceedings can also be included. Don't forget - we'll come to you! Schools that can't get to the Legislative Building can have the Classroom in the Legislature brought to their school!
