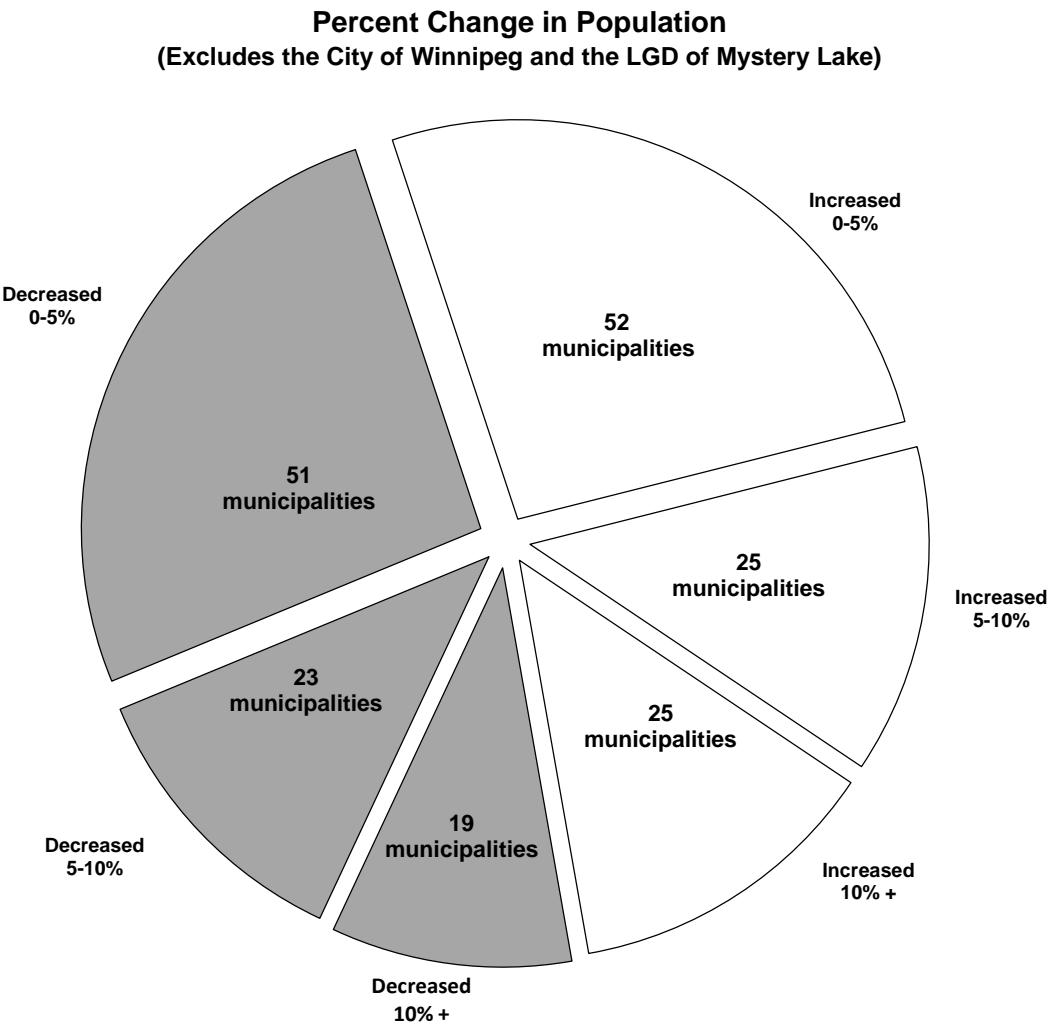


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

CHANGES IN MUNICIPAL POPULATION

Population Change over 5 Years - 2006 to 2011 Census



Population increased in 102 or 52% of municipalities

- 50 or 25% of municipalities increased more than 5%

Large municipalities (more than 5,000 residents) had the largest increases

- Of the 25 municipalities that increased more than 10%, 9 have more than 5,000 residents

Population decreased in 93 or 48% of municipalities

- 42 or 22% of municipalities decreased more than 5%, including 19 or 10% that decreased over 10%

Small municipalities (less than 1,000 residents) had the largest decreases

- Of the 19 municipalities that decreased more than 10%, 14 have less than 1,000 residents
