Economic Overview

Residents engage in commercial fishing on Lake Winnipeg. Fishers use the Catfish Creek, George's Island, Jackhead, Koostatak and McBeth fish stations. Some income is generated from trapping in open areas which are not part of a Registered Trapline Zone.
