National Mills

Community Overview

History

National Mills is one of a group of five in close proximity including Baden, Red Deer Lake, Powell and Barrows. It was built as a result of small logging during the years of the sawmill operations on the edge of the Porcupine Provincial Forest. There is no longer any permanent residents.

Access

National Mills is located on Provincial Trunk Highway (PTH) 77 between Barrows 10 kilometres (km) to the east and Westgate four km to the west. PTH 77 connects Mafeking and PTH 10 with Saskatchewan.

Governance

National Mills is recognized as a community under The Northern Affairs Act. There is no council in place.

Economic Overview

The area is heavily forested and forest harvesting continues to be the dominant economic activity. Soils have potential for agricultural applications in the mixed farming sector. Trapping is carried out as part of the Porcupine and Shoal River Registered Trapline Zones.
