AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT



RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and DUHA PRINTERS (WESTERN) LIMITED, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Duha Printers (Western) Limited filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of a plant for the production of lacquered display materials and plastic covered stationery binders, the said plant being located at or near 609 Greenwood Avenue in the Town of Selkirk, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a regulation the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS

after giving notice of its intention to prescribe limits, terms and conditions the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person likely to be affected;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission considered the proposal on the 17th day of March, 1987;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The Applicant shall limit odour emissions to such an extent that, at any point of impingement off the site of the said operation, odours emanating from the said operation are not detectable:
 - in a residential area or commercial area when one volume of odorous air is diluted with one equal volume of odour-free air;
 - (b) in an industrial area when one volume of odorous air is diluted with six equal volumes of odour-free air.
