AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE TOWN OF STEINBACH, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Town of Steinbach filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of a swimming pool located in the NW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 7, Range 6 EPM in the said Town, with discharge of filter backwash water to the Manning Channel;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a regulation, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS

after giving notice of its intention to set limits, terms and conditions, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission considered the proposal on the 30th day of March, 1988:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The Applicant shall not discharge backwash water from the said swimming pool where the coliform content of a 100 millilitre sample of the effluent, as indicated by the MPN Index, is in excess of
 - 200 fecal coliforms;
 - (b) 1500 total coliforms.
