The applicant shall comply with the following limits, terms and conditions for the construction and management of a four-celled impoundment, located east of the Town of Arden, on sections 20, 21, 29, and 32, Township 15, Range 13 1WPM and sections 5, 6, 8, 17, 18, and 19, Township 16, Range 13 1WPM for the purpose of irrigating natural vegetation by backflooding in accordance with the information filed within the Environment Act Proposal Form dated February 7, 1991:

- (1) Construction shall not proceed until the proponent has provided written evidence to the Director that a Licence has been obtained pursuant to the Water Rights Act from the Water Resources Branch, Manitoba Department of Natural Resources or the requirements of the Water Rights Act have been satisfactorily met should such a licence not be required; and
- (2) All earthworks shall be stabilized in order to prevent soil erosion, with the use of rock or concrete armour, planting of artificial mixtures of plants, natural re-vegetation, and other appropriate measures that may be specified by the Director; and
- (3) Construction shall not proceed until the proponent has provided, satisfactory to the Director, detailed engineering plans for the project prepared by a qualified engineer.
