THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

Fish Futures Inc.: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a fish spawning enhancement project on Hamilton Creek in 6-9-17E in Whiteshell Provincial Park subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications. Limits. Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated October 25, 1993.
- 2. The Licencee shall, prior to beginning construction activities, provide proof of permission for access to the right-of-way of TransCanada PipeLines to the Eastern Regional Office of Manitoba Natural Resources.
- 3. The Licencee shall protect erodible streambanks disturbed by construction with riprap and reseed exposed soil with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 4. The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 5. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.

Revocation

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
