In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF OCHRE RIVER: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a low level stream crossing of the Ochre River on the municipal road allowance north of NE 4-23-17W in the Rural Municipality of Ochre River subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated May 6, 1994 and the supplementary information contained in aletter to Manitoba Environment dated August 11, 1994.
- 2. The Licencee shall, prior to beginning construction activities for the Development, submit, for the approval of the Director, a final construction drawing for the Development.
- 3. The Licencee shall ensure that the Development is constructed in accordance with the Manitoba Natural Resources publication "Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba".
- 4. The Licencee shall notify Manitoba Natural Resources staff not less than two weeks prior to beginning construction activities, and shall obtain on-site advice from Manitoba Natural Resources for the invert elevations of the waterway openings.
- 5. The Licencee shall stabilize the entire width of the stream bed with rip rap within 4 m of the upstream side and 10 m of the downstream side of the concrete portion of the Development.
- 6. The Licencee shall reseed all non rip rapped areas disturbed by construction with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 7. The Licencee shall institute a program of regular inspections of the Development and remove accumulated debris as necessary to ensure that flow through the waterway openings is not excessively restricted.

- 8. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction and operation of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 9. The Licencee shall ensure that any temporary fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall be developed at a minimum of 100 metres from the high water mark of the Ochre River and shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.

Revocation

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
