THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: the "Licencee"

STAGE 1 LICENCE

for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Development being the upgrading of Provincial Road #354 from the west limit of Section 32-19-19W to Provincial Road #270 (Section 1) in the Local Government District of Park subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with The Environment Act Proposal of the Proposed Upgrading of Provincial Road #354 from the Junction of PR 250 to the Junction of PR 270 in the L.G.D. of Park, dated March 6, 1995.
- 2. The Licencee shall, prior to construction startup, instruct the on-site project construction supervisor to arrange a pre-construction meeting with representatives of Manitoba Environment's regional office in Brandon and the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources' Brandon regional office in order to ensure ongoing compliance with the specifications, limits, terms and conditions of this Licence during the term of construction of the Development.
- 3. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, obtain a work permit from the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Shoal Lake District Office to cut trees from Crown Land along the right-of-way on SW 6-20-19W.
- 4. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, identify and mark the three large spruce trees located along the property line in the SE 5-20-19W to ensure that the trees are not affected by construction.
- 5. The Licencee shall, during construction, relocate a minimum of 50 spruce trees from the road allowance and proposed right-of-way to areas surrounding the curves in SE 5-20-19W.
- 6. The Licencee shall, following construction of the Development, construct a new wetland area to replace the marsh habitat affected by the construction located at Camp Wannakumbac intersection.

- 7. The Licencee shall, during construction, locate the hydro line within the expanded road right-of-way to avoid clearing outside the expanded right-of-way.
- 8. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that any fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from waterbodies including wetlands and ensure the storage areas comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products Regulation.
- 9. The Licencee shall, during and upon completion of construction of the Development, collect and dispose of all waste petroleum products in accordance with all applicable regulatory requirements.
- 10. The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 150/91 Waste Disposal Grounds Regulation.
- 11. The Licencee shall, at the completion of the construction of the Development, landscape and vegetate all areas disturbed during the construction with native plant species or cultivars.

REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, limits, terms and conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
