AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION



UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: The Clean Environment Commission and Carman Vegetable Storage Ltd., applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Carman Vegetable Storage Ltd., has submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a potato washing and storage facility located on Section 19-6-4 WPM in the R. M. of Dufferin,

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the Clean Environment Commission by any person who is or is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation,

AND WHEREAS the Clean Environment Commission considered the application on the 15th day of January, 1974,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The applicant shall ensure that all liquid waste is retained on the property of Carman Vegetable Storage Limited,
- The applicant shall ensure that solid waste from the operation is disposed of in such a manner so as to minimize the release of offensive odours,
- The applicant shall ensure that the truck washing operation is carried out in such a manner and location as approved by the Clean Environment Commission,
- 4. The applicant shall in writing notify the Clean Environment Commission of any major change or expansion of the existing facilities.
